Guidelines

You are invited to submit 2 and 3 dimensional art and photography not previously displayed at the Chautauqua Indoor Art & Photography Show. This year there is no statute of limitations for timeline of created works. Pieces will be separated by medium and professional/amateur level. A professional artist is described as being gallery represented, as having formal training, or making part or their entire livelihood from the selling of works.

Art and photography will be judged separately, and each will feature separate student categories (ages 12 and under and ages 13-18). Cash and ribbon awards will be given and the judge's decision is final.

2d Mediums: Drawing: Pen & Ink, Pencil, and Pastel/Charcoal.
Painting: Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Mixed Media

NEW! 3 D Mediums: Pottery vessels, Metal Sculpture, Ceramics Sculpture, Jewelry, and Mixed Media

Photography categories include: Black & White, Portraiture, Landscape, Nature, Abstract, and Digital Art (Manipulated in Photoshop until photo no longer resembles original)

Size: Works must be framed and ready for hanging with wire and must not exceed 48 inches (including frame). Each piece MUST be tagged with the title of the piece and the name of the artist. There will be an extra \$5 charge PER ENTRY that is not ready to hang.

Tags: Are downloadable and MUST be affixed to the back, bottom right of all framed, ready to hang entries

Entry fees: \$5 each with a limit of three (4) entries per participant. Student fees are \$2 each with a limit of three (4) entries.

Entry Deadline: Entry forms and fees must be postmarked by or received before June 7, 2019. However, depending on space available some entries may be accepted at the door on June 13th. **Checks are made payable to "Wythe Arts Council, Ltd."**

It is the responsibility of the artist to make certain entry fees have been received. Entries with no entry fee will not be accepted!

Delivery of Work: Works must be hand delivered to the former Wytheville Community Center downstairs at the corner of 4th and Spring Streets on Thursday, June 13, 2019, promptly from 4 pm to 7 pm. **No works will be accepted prior to 4pm or after 7pm.**

Entries must be picked up Sunday June 23, 2019 between 10 am & 1 pm. Any entries not picked up on June 23rd will be given to the Wythe Arts Council and will no longer be the responsibility of the Chautauqua Committee.

Every security precaution will be taken, but the Chautauqua Committee and the Wythe Arts Council cannot be held responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged articles. The committee also reserves the right to reject any entries deemed offensive by community standards and if less than six entries per category, cash prizes MAY NOT be awarded. If your entries are available for sale, please indicate the purchase price on the entry form. There will be a 15% commission on all sales. Proceeds go toward the Chautauqua Festival.
